

100% strongly agree/agree that their child feels safe




95% strongly agree/agree bullying has been dealt with quickly and effectively

You said...

I think more work needs to be done to support children who are emotionally sensitive and this work needs to be regular and consistent and there needs to be more communication with the parents as to the actions that are being taken and how this will be taken forward throughout the year and also what parents can do at home to support the child. Saying that whenever my child has had an issue, the school have supported them swiftly and have been very supportive.

You said...

Extra work for children that want to do extra work on an evening. It would be great if there was access to an app or learning programme where children can do extra work during the week.

We have...

Last year, we adopted My Happy Mind as a programme to support children's mental health and wellbeing. The children have a weekly lesson on subjects such as how we cope with our feeling and how we develop positive relationships. There is an APP for parents to download to use at home. In addition, Mrs wareham is our Emotional Literacy Mentor who is available to support children's emotional wellbeing when it is needed and for as long as is needed.

If parents are concerned about their child's wellbeing, please speak to someone in school.

We have...

At Field Lane, our KS1/2 children have access to Purple Mash, TTRockstars and NumBots which can be accessed at home. Homework is set on a weekly basis on Class Dojo. In addition to this, the parent topic sheets have a list of suggested activities that children can do at home.

My child requires more support in certain subjects and we feel there needs to be a stronger focus on this.

You said...

For Nursery my my son comes in the afternoon and has missed the career visits in the morning. It would be nice to have the same for afternoon children too. Also more updates would be great on individual children on Class Dojo.

The only thing I would say is, I would love to see pictures/videos of my child being uploaded on Dojo so that we can see what she gets up to.

We have...

We take all forms of bullying seriously and contact parents/carers immediately when we have concerns. We take part in Anti bullying week and talk to our children about what bullying means and how to get support. In addition to this, we have some children in Y5/6 training as mental health champions and they will be able to support any children who are feeling sad or lonely.

We have...

Teachers have been trained in adapting their teaching to cater for the needs of all children in their class. However, maths and reading interventions or therapies are in place for those children who need additional support.

We have...

All Nursery children will have the opportunity to participate in all events.
